AHRA Education Foundation Announces 2004 Broadley Scholarship Program

New program anticipates 2 scholarships awarded in 2004

(Sudbury, Mass., March 29, 2004) – The American Healthcare Radiology Administrators (AHRA) Education Foundation announced today that applications for the new 2004 Broadley Scholarship Program are being accepted. The application deadline is May 15, 2004.

The Broadley Scholarship Program was established to honor Louise Broadley, FAHRA, a long-time leader of AHRA. Consistent with Louise's contributions to the careers of countless administrators and radiologic technologists, this program provides scholarship support to radiology administrators desiring to enhance their careers through education. The AHRA Education Foundation anticipates that 2 Broadley scholarships of \$2,500 each will be awarded in 2004.

The scholarships will be presented to AHRA members who are: 1) a current active member of the AHRA and in good standing for at least three consecutive years, 2) have been accepted into an initial undergraduate or initial graduate degree program relevant to a supervisory career in a medical imaging field prior to submitting application, 3) at time of application, hold a supervisory position within a medical imaging department or imaging center and have held such a position for at least 1 year. Previous Broadley Scholarship awardees will be ineligible to reapply for the Broadley Scholarship. Members are eligible to receive 1 Broadley Scholarship only.

All applicants must submit the following: 1) completed application, 2) completed recommendation form from applicant's supervisor, 3) completed recommendation form from a current AHRA member currently employed in an imaging position. 4) resume or curriculum vitae, 5) letter of intent highlighting professional accomplishments to date, educational and career goals, impact the undergraduate or graduate degree sought will have on achieving these goals, intended use of scholarship money, anticipated funding of expenses in the absence of a Broadley Scholarship, and documentation of acceptance into an undergraduate or graduate program.

All applications for the 2004 AHRA Education Foundation Broadley Scholarship Program must be complete and received on or before May 15, 2004. A volunteer task force of AHRA members will review applications. 2004 Broadley Scholarship recipients will be mailed notification by June 30, 2004.
